I write to inform all Fresh Students of 2023/2024 and Graduating Students referencing WAEC letter on O'Level results verification and validation dated Friday 11th August, 2023 that WAEC has launched a **Digital Certificate Verification Platform (DCVP)**.

The importance of this, is for integrity and authenticity of the O'Level results presented by candidates who gain admission into higher institutions of learning across the federation and graduating students. This Digital Certificate Verification Platform (DCVP) is for Institutions, Organizations, Agencies, Embassies, High Commissions and the general public.

With this development the Acting Vice-Chancellor has approved that Ignatius Ajuru University of Education (IAUE) be onboard in the digital platform for original WAEC Certificate verification and sharing which validates the O'Level results submitted to the University by the candidates and students.

The process will also ensure the validation of transcripts and academic results for document integrity and originality.

To this end, all Clearing Officers in the Admissions Unit and Faculty Officers should direct all candidates without the physical original O'level Certificate for verification and validation to the Registrar's Office (Admissions Unit). All graduating students O'level results are to be verified/validated through this digital method on the desk of the Special Assistant to the Registrar.

Therefore, all incoming students (candidates) and graduating students should follow the under listed measure for digital certificate verification and validation:

Procedure for Students of Ignatius Ajuru University of Education

- Log on to www.waec.org to create a candidate's account
- Select 'Certificate Access' (candidates)' category
- Fill the form and sign up
- Login with your details
- Fill the required information
- Access Certificate
- Click the 'share' button
- Select the certificate you wish to share, enter recipient's (institution's) email address – registrar@iaue.edu.ng and proceed.

Candidates must ensure they enter the recipient's email address correctly to avoid multiple entries.
